Background and approach



Background and objectives

In April 2022, Local Space commissioned IFF Research to conduct a survey to collect the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) information of tenants living in properties owned by Local Space. EDI data refers to the 9 protected characteristics of the UK Equality Act 2010. Up to date and accurate EDI data will help Local Space to better understand their tenants and to shape their services to meet their needs.



<u>Sample</u>

Local Space provided a sample file to IFF Research that included the contact details of tenants in Local Space owned properties. This file comprised a total of 593 tenants from 545 households.

Survey approach





117 telephone 64 online

= 181 interviews

The survey was designed to collect the full range of EDI data on the tenant who was answering the survey as well as to ask a trimmed down, and less personal, set of EDI questions of other household members.

Tenants were initially invited, by email, to complete the survey online. IFF interviewers also called tenants to conduct the survey by phone and to remind/signpost them to the online survey. As an incentive to take part in the survey, tenants who completed the survey were entered into a prize draw to win £200.


Between 16th May – 8th June 2022, 181 surveys were completed. Each of these surveys represents a household, from which we collected data on a total of 488 individual household members.



Age, Sex & Gender Reassignment of tenants





The majority of tenants who answered the survey are over the age of 35. 98% said their gender was the same as registered at birth, and 73% are female

A4: How would you describe your gender? All tenants who answered the survey, n=181


Disability profile of tenants




A quarter of tenants who answered the survey have a physical or mental health condition/illness expected to last more than 12 months. There was no difference in proportion whether they were female (26%) or male (24%).

Almost half of the men (45%) who reported a disability, said they had a long term illness

A third of the women (35%) who reported a disability had a mental health impairment. Overall, this equates to 9% of the female tenants who answered the survey with a mental health impairment.




Sexual orientation & marriage and civil partnership profile of tenants



85% of the tenants said they were Heterosexual/ straight, 10% chose not to answer the question about their sexuality.

38% had never married or been in a civil partnership, 32% are currently married or in a civil partnership, 19% are separated and 3% are widowed.

Pregnancy and maternity of tenants





A combined 4% of tenants said they were pregnant or currently an expectant parent and 1% is currently on paternity leave. Men are more likely to be in full time paid work than women at 51% compared 32% for women.

- Prefer not to say








Religion or belief & ethnicity of tenants




Black/ Black British African was the most common ethnicity at 32%. Christian religions were the most common with a combined 50% describing their religion as such, followed by 31% describing themselves as Muslim.










Number of Household members



The majority of households were multiple occupancy (72%). In addition to the 181 tenants who answered the survey, data was collected on a limited range of questions for 307 other household members. Meaning data was collected for a total of 488 individuals living in 181 households. Most of the other household members were children/dependents (81%) of the survey respondents


B3: How many others not mentioned live in your household? *All tenants who answered the survey, n=181* B8: What is their relationship to you? *Other household members, n=307*




Age & Gender of household members



There were more female household members than male (57% vs 41%). 49% of male household members are younger than 20, compared to 32% of female household members.

Disability profile of household members




Overall, 18% have a physical/mental health condition/illness expected to last more than 12 months

There was a significant gender difference in some conditions, with more males (26%) having learning or understanding problems than females (2%). Males were also more likely to suffer from social or behavioural problems than females (17% vs 2%).

Conversely, females (33%) were more likely to have a mental health impairment than males (11%).



Ethnicity of household members



In line with the profile of lead/joint tenants the largest ethnic group across all household members is Black/Black African (32%). A quarter of household members are White/White British.



A11/B11: How would you describe their ethnicity? All household members, n=488




Rent arrears and tenancy start date



Tenancy start date

While base sizes are low, this survey suggests that over time, the proportion of tenancies with Black British / African is increasing, and the proportion of White British tenancies is decreasing




A10: How would you describe your ethnicity? All tenants who answered the survey, n=181 (Black / Black British – African, n=58; White – other, n=21; White British, n=24)



Rent arrears/credit

Among the tenants who answered the survey, 25% were in arrears, this figure was slightly higher among White British respondents at 29% and among the able bodied respondents at 28%





Comparison with Local Space staff



Age & Gender of tenants compared with Local Space Staff








A2: What is your date of birth? *All tenants, n=181*A4: How would you describe your gender? *All tenants, n=181*Local Space Staff Data, n=43



Area based on property postcode




